*(Curtain opens. Center stage is Levi holding Melanie's hand, turned toward them are the nurses and the doctor. Kyla is behind Melanie. Chris and Mr. Walker stand close to each other. Donna and Brian are together. All are listening as the doctor speaks.)*

Doctor: He's released to go home. Take good care of him and if you see ANYTHING that concerns you or even something that is just different than it was before, give us a call.

Melanie: Doctor, I don't know how to thank you. You saved my little boy, you gave him his life back.

Doctor: It wasn't me, God gets all the credit. You heard the preacher praying for God to direct the surgeon's hands. All I can say is, it was a miracle from the beginning to the end.

Levi: But, doctor, you said you didn't know God.

Doctor (bending down toward Levi): Levi, because of you and Dawnetta, I had a brand new look at God. Remember the verse you told me to memorize, I know it now. John 3:16: For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. I believe in Him now.

Levi (brightly): So now you have ever-last-ing life, too.

Brian (moves toward Levi): I believe, too. Just before Dawnetta died, she asked me to promise to love God and her mother. I had to think about that for a long, long time. And then I remembered you said that Jesus gives us everlasting life. I asked Donna to help me find out more. So she got the Bible and we started reading about everlasting life, then I started going to church. I am a Christian now. Levi, I don't know how to thank you for taking my little girl to church with you.

Levi: You've already given me the greatest gift a man could give. You let your daughter be the reason I can live. (Gives Brian a hug, then turns to give Donna a hug.) Mrs. Tolbert, thanks for letting Dawnetta be my friend. We'll both miss her.

*(The caste, or the choir, or a soloist could sing "Give Of Your Best to the Master.")*

*(Curtain can be closed here and the closing words can be given in front of the curtains OR the caste can remain quietly in place as the minister moves to front center stage for his closing words.)*

*(The closing can be replaced by words from your minister or director if desired).*

Minister: John 3:36 says: He that believeth on the Son hath **everlasting life**: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life. We hope this program has helped you to think about your own life, your own relationship to God, and your relationship to others. Many of you have endured tragedy or severe health problems, some of you have had your own miracle. Many of you were raised in a loving, Christian home. Some of you wonder what the meaning of home is. Many of you are surrounded by loved ones. Some of you wonder if anyone cares. Many of you feel God has blessed your life. Some of you feel that God has given you more than you can bear. Some of you are making some choices that will change your life forever. Some of you are trying to change some of the choices that you have already made. However, most of you are here in honor of the Giver of Everlasting Life. No matter your circumstances, the most important question for each one is: Do you know Him as your personal savior? If you don't know Him, He asks us to believe on him and have everlasting life. Revelation 3:20 says: Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him.

I would ask that each of you commit or re-commit your heart and life to Jesus, the Giver of Everlasting Life. He Gave His Life that we might live.
